Open to registered mares and geldings four years old or over, not exceeding 128 cm. Riders not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit.

** 2 Highest placed WPBR and Pure Bred Welsh eligible for MINI WPCS performance medal championship**

Class 52 – Show Pony/Hunter Type Leading Rein

Open to registered mares and geldings four years old or over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday by 1st January in the current year. Snaffle bridle only. The 2 highest placed registered WPBR Lead Rein ponies will qualify for the National Welsh Ridden Part Bred Lead Rein Championship.

** 2 Highest placed WPBR and Pure Bred Welsh eligible for MINI WPCS performance medal championship**

Class 53 – Show Pony/ Hunter Type First Ridden

Open to registered mares and geldings four years old or over. Not exceeding 122cms. Snaffle bridle only. Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday by 1st January in the current year. The 2 highest placed registered WPBR First Ridden ponies will qualify for the National Welsh First Ridden Part Bred Championship.

2 Highest placed WPBR and Pure Bred Welsh eligible for MINI WPCS performance medal championship

Class 54 – M & M Leading Rein

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 122 cm. must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bit. The 2 highest placed registered Welsh Sec A and 2 Sec B ponies will qualify for the National Supreme Brynseion Stud Ridden Lead Rein Championship.

** 2 Highest placed Pure Bred Welsh eligible for MINI WPCS performance medal championship**

Class 55 – M & M First Ridden

Open to registered Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest, Welsh Section A or B mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128 cm. Riders not reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. The 2 highest placed registered Welsh Sec A and 2 Sec B ponies will qualify for the National Supreme Brynseion Stud First Ridden Championship.

** 2 Highest placed WPBR and Pure Bred Welsh eligible for MINI WPCS performance medal championship**

1. For Palominos registered with the British Palomino Society and owned by a paid up member of the Society. Current membership badge should be carried when in the ring. Whips – show canes only, max 30" (76cm) with NO attachments. No schooling/dressage whips permitted – this applies to Ridden AND Inhand classes. Inhand exhibits must be shown with free manes and tails. For Ridden classes plaiting/hogging is optional.
2. The Palomino Champion (if InHand) qualifies for the BPS Champion of Champions Inhand final (See BPS website for more information). If the Champion has qualified (or is a Ridden) the Reserve can receive the qualification. This must be printed alongside the championship information.
3. The winner of the Ridden class qualifies for the BPS Champion of Champions Ridden final (See BPS website for more information).

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

1. The Organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, accident or injury to Person, Animal or property.
2. The Judges decision is final. All objections must lodged in writing to the Secretary, within half an hour of a class. A deposit of £25 must accompany the objection and will be forfeit if the objection is not upheld.
3. All equines in medal classes must be registered with the W.P.C.S.- except foals unless they are 6 months old.
4. The Committee reserve the right to amalgamate classes if less than three entries are received.
5. Brood Mares, Stallions and ridden Equines must be four years or over.
6. All foals must be over three weeks old.
7. Exhibitors are not allowed to show any equine under a Judge who has owned, bred, or had any financial interest in, or produced for gain, the said animal.
8. No equine can be awarded more than one medal in any year (Silver/Gold/Ridden medals excepted) If the Champion and reserve have already won medals, the medal will be withheld.
9. All trophies and cups remain the property of the Association and must be returned in good condition and in good time for the next years show.
10. Whips and Canes No shaft of any whip or cane shall exceed 75cms (30 inches).
11. It is the exhibitors responsibility to present their exhibit at the ring on time for their class, not the responsibility of the announcer.
12. A BROOD MARE IS A MARE THAT HAS PRODUCED A FOAL, LIVE OR DEAD (VETS CERTIFICATE REQUIRED) IN THE CURRENT YEAR, ALL OTHER MARES ARE CLASSED AS BARREN.
13. Ridden Welsh Classes are run under WP&CS Rules **Novices** -: A Pony/Cob/Welsh Part-Bred shall be deemed to be a Novice if, by 1st January of the current year, it has not won an Open class within the discipline in which it is currently competing. All Novice ridden animals must be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle.
14. All Ridden Equines must be 4 years old or over.
15. WPCS RULE 9.7.2 AS FROM THE 1ST JANUARY 2014
Animals, 3 years old and under including foals must not be body clipped for showing purposes. Long hair under the jawline and those protruding from the ears may be trimmed off leaving as natural a line as possible. The whiskers around the muzzle may be trimmed.
16. All colts/stallion 2yr and over must be bitted and lead by a handler that is 14 or over on the 1st of January in the current year
17. All handlers under the age of 14 must wear a British Standard Hard Hat, gloves and suitable footwear.
18. Riders of stallions 13.2hh and under must be 12 years old as of 1st January and riders of stallions over 13.2hh must be 14 years of age as of the 1st of January.
19. Entry fee's will not be refunded without a Veterinary Certificate
20. If the show is cancelled all entry fee's will be returned unless the show is rescheduled then no fee's will be returned.
